VISP staff provides personalized advising as well as a variety of cultural and social events to help you feel welcome and enjoy your time on campus and in the surrounding communities.


International students can study at UW–Madison during the fall, spring or summer terms.

Estimated cost of attendance*

Costs vary by number of credits and length of program. Here are examples from our most common session options:

4-week summer session

Most students enroll in a 3-credit class, which costs approximately \$5,000

8-week summer session

Most students enroll in 6-9 credits (2-3 classes), which costs approximately \$10,000

Estimated living expenses

Students should plan on approximately \$2,000 per month. This includes an estimate for housing, meals, SHIP health insurance and other incidentals.

Extra opportunities

UW-Madison offers an exciting and vibrant campus and surrounding community. In addition to coursework, VISP participants explore extracurricular activities to meet other students and learn about life as a U.S. college student.
