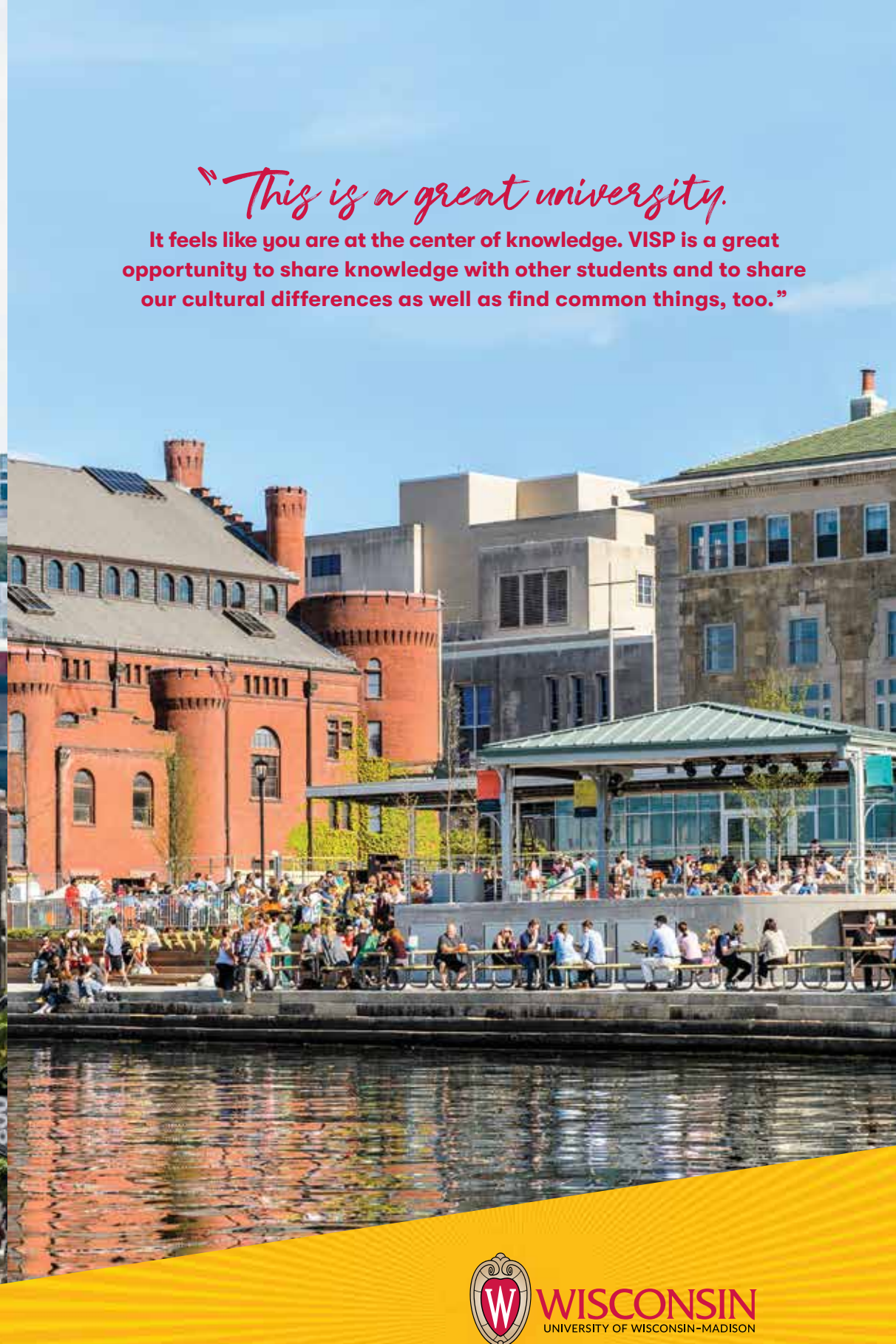
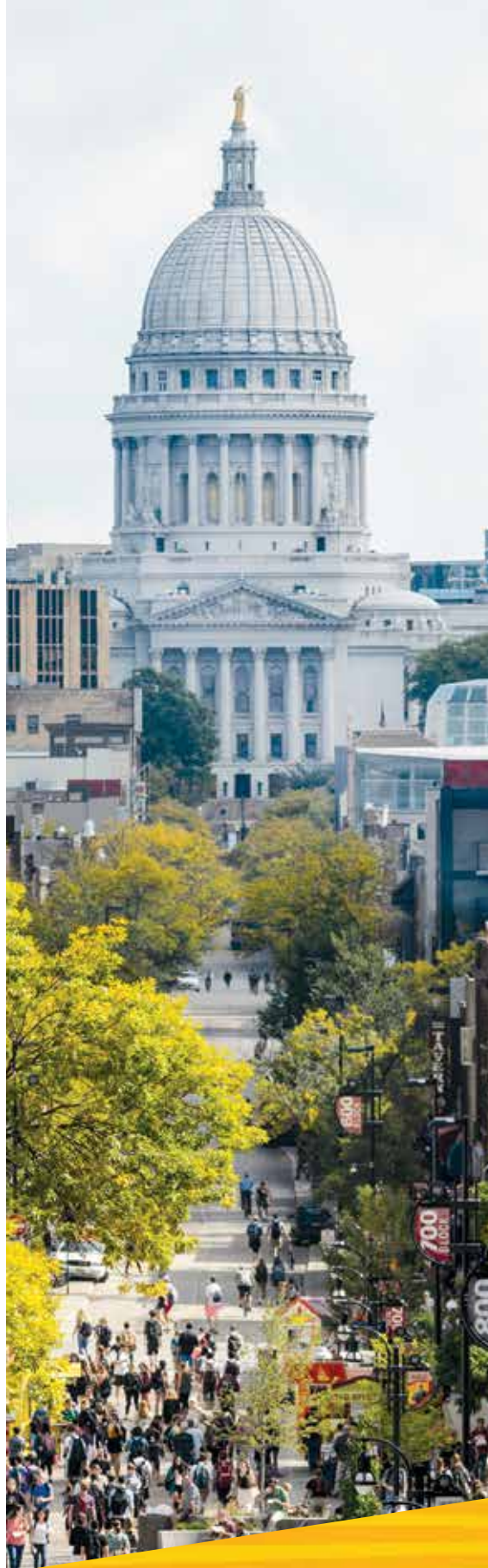
VISP staff provides personalized advising as well as a variety of cultural and social events to help you feel welcome and enjoy your time on campus and in the surrounding communities.

Estimated cost of attendance[†]

Costs vary by number of credits and length of program. Here are examples from our most common session options:

4-week summer session

Most students enroll in a 3-credit class, which costs approximately \$5,000

8-week summer session

Most students enroll in 6-9 credits (2-3 classes), which costs approximately \$10,000

Estimated living expenses

Students should plan on approximately \$2,000 per month. This includes an estimate for housing, meals, SHIP health insurance and other incidentals.

Extra opportunities

UW–Madison offers an exciting and vibrant campus and surrounding community. In addition to coursework, VISP participants explore extracurricular activities to meet other students and learn about life as a U.S. college student.

You can volunteer in the community, walk on a lakeshore path or go boating, among many other options. VISP students go on excursions to have locally made ice cream on the Union Terrace, visit one of the best farmers' markets in the country or cheer at a baseball game.

Apply

We recommend applying by mid-March for the most flexibility with housing and class selection, but we accept applications on a rolling basis after that. Summer Term course enrollment starts in April.
